1. **Are there any statewide policies or initiatives that are anticipated to be submitted or discussed during the upcoming legislative session that your organization would like to share or would require support.**

Reinstate small school size adjustment for urban schools. Most small urban schools are charter schools and will be impacted that have less than 2000 students in the district. Silver Consolidated School District has around 2,300 students. This bill would affect Aldo Leopold Charter School, 6th street school and Cliff schools.

- a. *Small school size adjustment accounts for 1/3 of the budget for charter schools that are around 200 students, like Aldo Leopold Charter School.*
- b. *This is a cut of over \$3,000 per student at these schools or about \$600,000/year. This would be devastating to Aldo. To put this in perspective one teacher cost approximately \$60,000/ year and we have 16 full time teachers.*
