- I. Convene / roll call Convened at 5:31 pm by AJ Sandoval, Chair via zoom and in-person meeting Roll call of Governing Board Council members: AJ Sandoval, Christa Osborn, Margaret Flores-Begay via zoom, Hannah Wecks, Max Higgs via zoom and Jamie Crockett via zoom.
 Others Present: Wayne Sherwood, Harry Browne and Sterling Wecks. Jim McIntosh and Fiona Bailey via zoom
- II. Agenda Review No changes. Motion to approve by Margaret Flores-Begay, Hannah Wecks seconded and all approved.
- III. Reading of the Mission and Vision AJ Sandoval
- IV. Review of June Meeting Minutes No changes. Motion to approve by Jamie Crockett, Hannah Wecks seconded and all approved.
- V. Public Comment No one present.
 - During this portion of our meeting, we welcome your suggestions and want to hear your concerns. This is not a question and answer period; speakers will be limited to five (5) minutes. Any individual who would like to discuss an item in more depth may request to be placed on a future agenda.
- VI. Student Council Report by Sterling Wecks Student Council elections went forward. President is Sterling Wecks. Vice President is Sarah Lynn. There are 3 senor representatives and 2 sophomore representatives. At the beginning of year, we will vote on freshman and all other school representatives. We will try to meet the first week of school.
- VII. Staff Report by Fiona Bailey We have been meeting via zoom. Curriculum meeting to come up with plans via hybrid and/or zoom. Dealing with some teacher concerns with face to face classes. Risk Management Committee is discussing guidelines and transportation. Mark Browne working on a class room with better videos and audio for zoom meetings.
- VIII. Business Manager Report by Harry Browne Reviewed BAR Work-based Learning Initiative, in the amount of \$60,000. Have to wait for a revised award letter that should come in August. GC already approved but we will have to again. All the requests of reimbursements made it on the deadlines. We

already got a couple approved. YCC is still outstanding and should go out on Monday. The legislation session changed the salary raise amount. Currently, Harry has a 1% salary raise for everyone with the exception of Wayne, Harry and Fiona. Health insurance could be a possibility. Harry will send bot options to GC: All with 1% salary raise and teachers only at 1% salary raise with no administrators (Wayne, Harry, and Fiona).

IX. Committee Reports

SAC - didn't meet

SHAC/Risk Management—Jim McIntosh shared summary. We had a double meeting with SHAC and Risk Management (RM) that focused on emotional and social well-being of students/teachers. We talked about continuing our outdoor programming. Most of the meeting was focused on SHAC mission and RM. All things that we do is safe. Had a lot of questions about transportation, class room set up and waiting to see what the guidelines will be. We have to adjust to the new normal.

Audit – We did have some sort of meeting. It was July 8th. There was a zoom meeting of about 30 people and head of auditing firm reviewed on how the audit is going to work. Elizabeth Nunoz is our auditor. We still don't have the date for the audit. Maybe sometime in early August.

Finance - didn't meet

Curriculum – Fiona shared that a group of High School teachers had ways to present material in a nomadic style. Grade level each day off campus if hybrid approach in groups of 10. If all virtual, we will need to change. Middle School is talking about one teacher that may not be able to come back to the classroom and may take the lead with other students not being able to come in. Lots of ideas being discussed. We have strong academia and need technology to support it. Emotional well-being of students is very important. Making sure we are reaching everyone. Really admire the creativity and dedication of staff. Things are moving forward.

Facilities – Wayne stated the Rich Hall's building improvements are moving along. We are pretty much done with the emergency door and sidewalk. Bathroom is almost done. We are in the process of putting back together the science lab. Hired a plumber to help. Outside area is being completed by YCC crew and JB Bjornstad. By end of the month, it will be completed.

Nominating — Hannah stated that they met and drafted a letter to send out copies to potential individuals who may be interested in becoming a GC member. Generating a list of organizations, Forest Service, WNMU, etc. Will send letter to major employer's (Freeport McMoran, Hospital, WNMU) HR staff and other groups (Rotary Club, Kiwanis, ALCD alums, etc.).

Policy – didn't meet

Development – didn't meet .

X. Directors Report – considering to start on-line curriculum due to the state Covid-19 numbers and governor's mandate. Cobra and Silver schools will be on-line. Then go to hybrid. Governor is cancelling all contact sports through NMAA. It will be a challenge to offer on-line quality education. Let's start all of our attention on our on-line curriculum. NMAA, all contact sports have cancelled. If the state Covid-19 numbers don't go down, school can't meet face to face. Numbers are emphasized by the governor. Currently, 28 cases and 10 new ones. 17 cases have recovered. AZ schools pushed their starting dates back. Wayne shared results of a parent survey. **Question:** How do you feel about sending your kids back to school? 40% responded to "oppose and strongly oppose." For starting our ALCS school date, Wayne proposed July 27th for teachers and students August 3rd for extended learning days. Maybe postpone students to August 10th. Therefore no change with the 2020/2021

school calendar. Teachers come back Aug 3rd on salary. We discussed volunteering on SHAC, RM and curriculum. Fiona stated that we need more time to get ready. Starting at original date makes more sense. It would be 184 days in service days. 172 schools days, 12 PD for 184, add 10 to 194. Then add 5 extra days to 199. 182 +12 in service days +5= 199 days. If we finish this school year with a large cash balance, it might go away. We have 2 more years to go through our small school adjustment. There is a potential of sweeping school's cash balances. Wayne suggested July 23rd start for teachers with seven in service days. Final start date proposal for the 2020/2021 school year is to go with July 27th for teachers and August 3rd for students. If teachers need more development training will make that available. If we approve July 23-24, will offer teachers a stipend for teachers working outside their contract time for various trainings.

- a. Nomination and vote of Governing Council Officers GC members discussed filling behind the Chair, Vice-Chair and Secretary positions for the GC board. Wayne stated that Andrea could possibly take notes. Christa Osborn's last day of secretary is today. Margaret stated that she could by available as secretary in September or October. GC secretary needs to keep the GC meeting binder current and finalize all signatures. After GC member discussion, AJ Sandoval volunteered to be Vice- Chair, Jamie Crockett would be Secretary, and Hannah Wecks as Chair. Then, Margaret Flores-Begay stated she would be Vice-Chair. Final decision is Hannah Wecks as Chair, Margaret Flores-Begay as Vice-Chair and Jamie Crockett as Secretary contingent on a note taker present. Christa Osborn motioned to approve, Jamie Crockett seconded and approved by all.
- b. Approval of School Directors Contract We discussed a 1% raise on top of \$96,000 which would be \$960. Hannah Wecks motioned to approve, Christa Osborn seconded and approved by all.
- c. Approval of School Calendar 2020-2021 -Start date of July 27th for teachers and students on Aug 3rd. Margaret Flores-Begay motioned to approve, Christa Osborn seconded and approved by all.
- d. Approval of BAR 21-01: \$60,000 for the Work-based Learning Initiative. Hannah Wecks motioned to approve, Margaret Flores-Begay seconded and approved by all.
