

Locovore Fruit Tree Mapping and Harvest

In this Experiential Education chapter of ELT, students will put to use, update, and refine a several-years-old locovore map of fruit trees in Silver City.

Additionally, students will engage in harvesting, preserving, and marketing (and eating!) fruit from local trees.

Much flexibility is built in to this workshop: students themselves will choose from and focus on the above class components which are of greatest interest to them. Independent work is encouraged, while comprehensive guidance is equally available.
