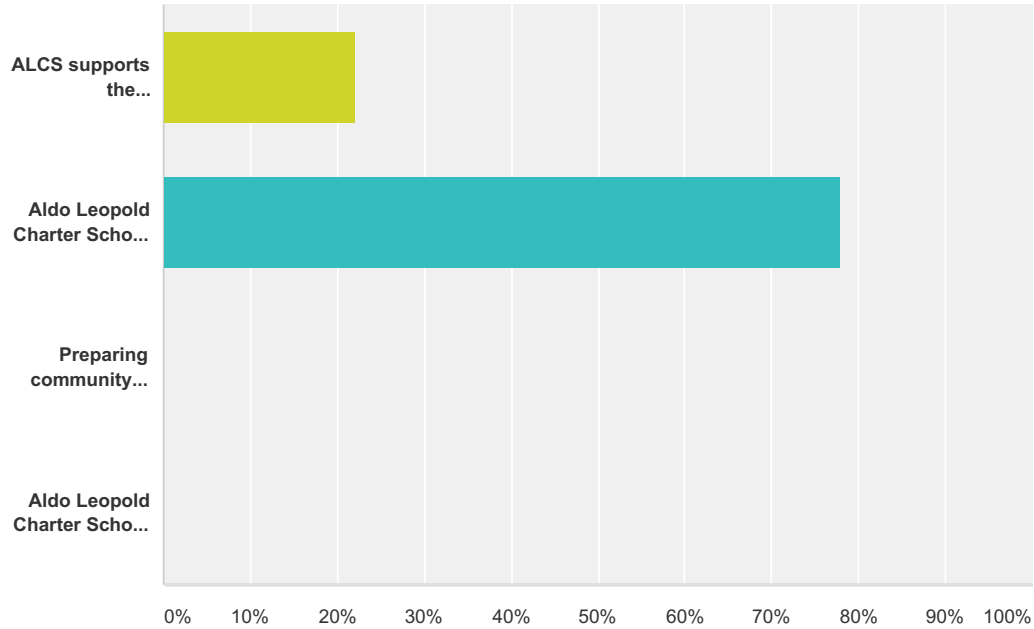

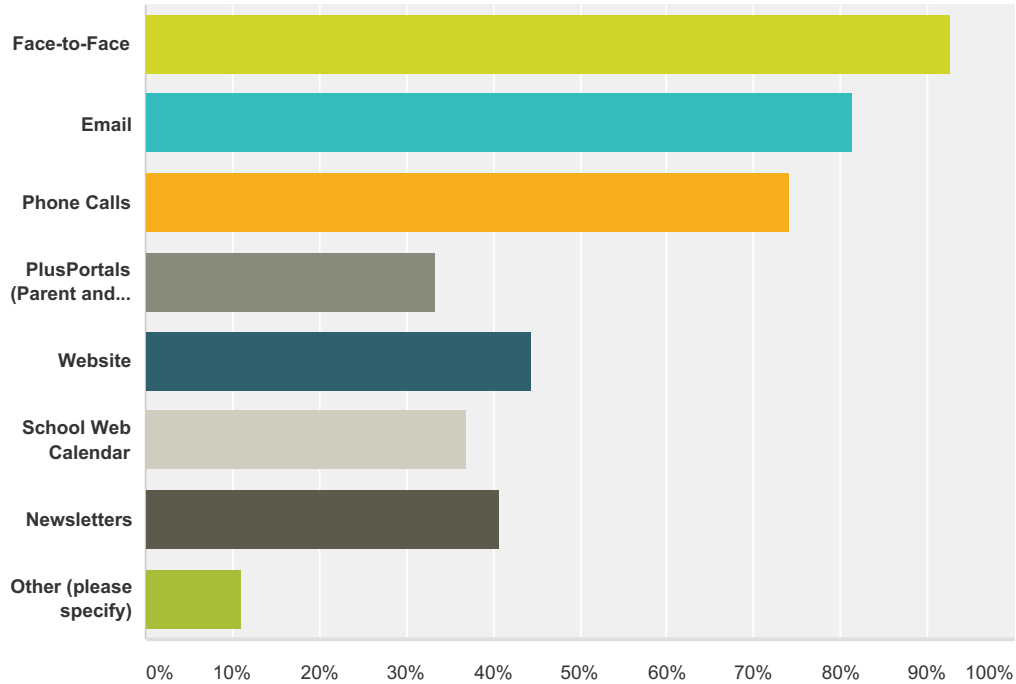

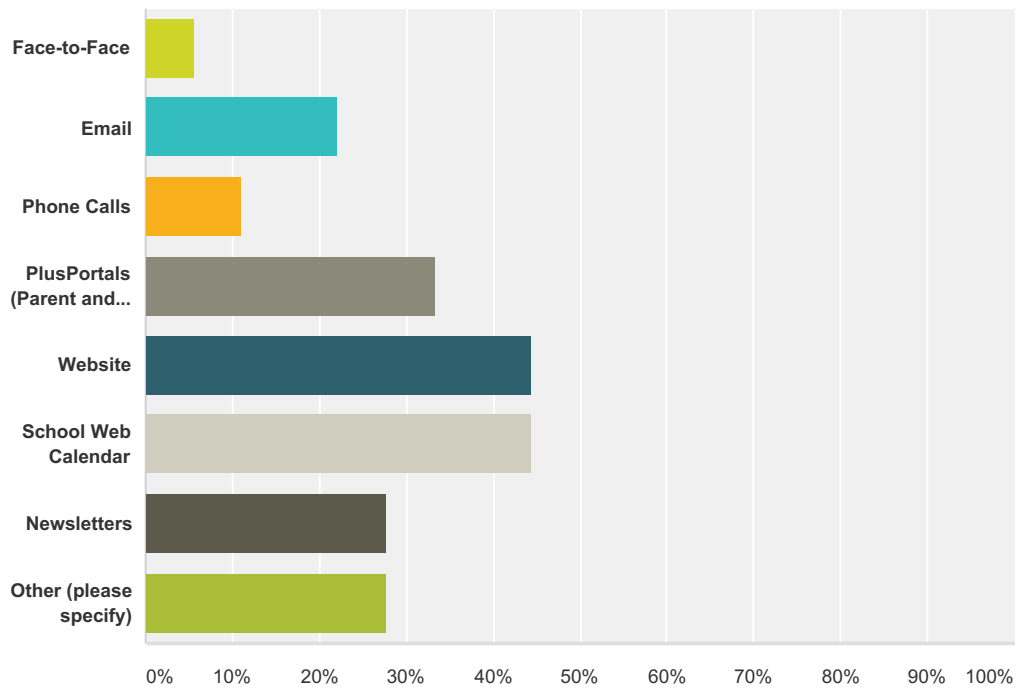

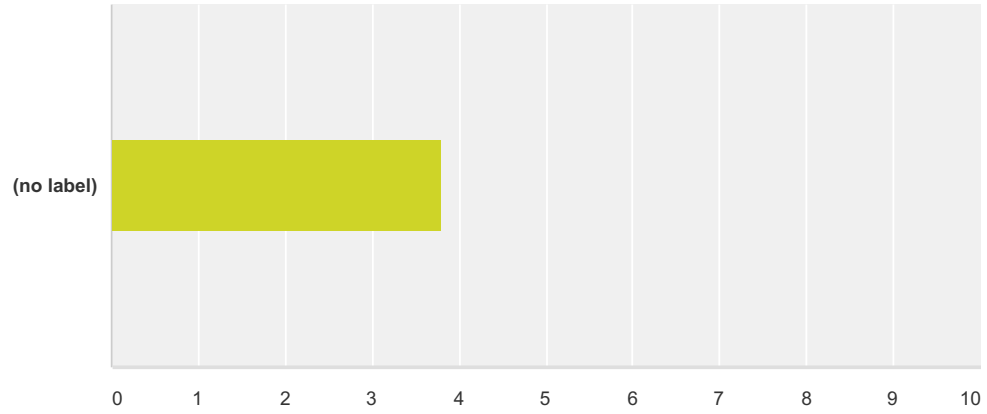

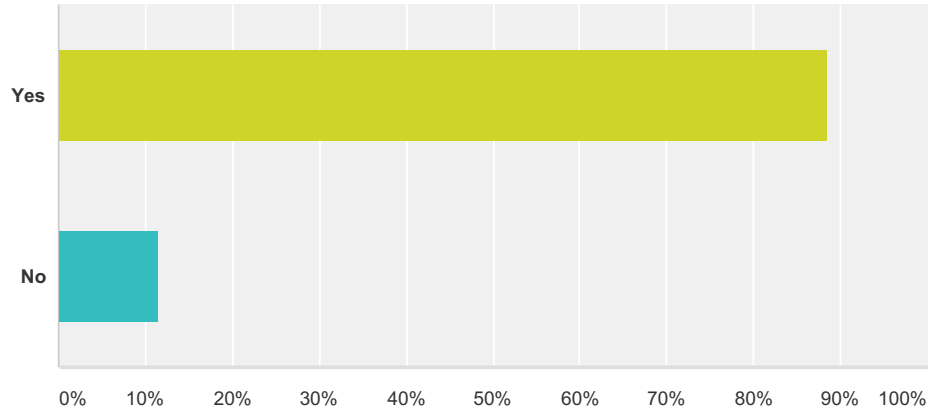

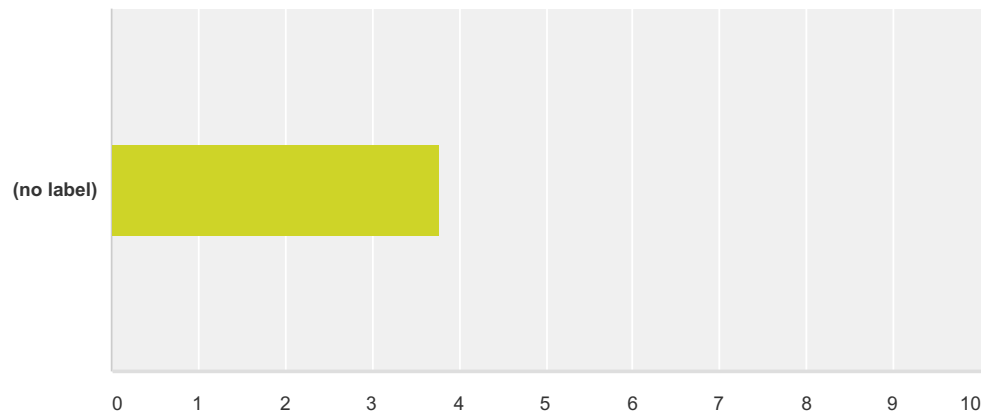

**Q9 Parents are involved in the decision making process at this school.**

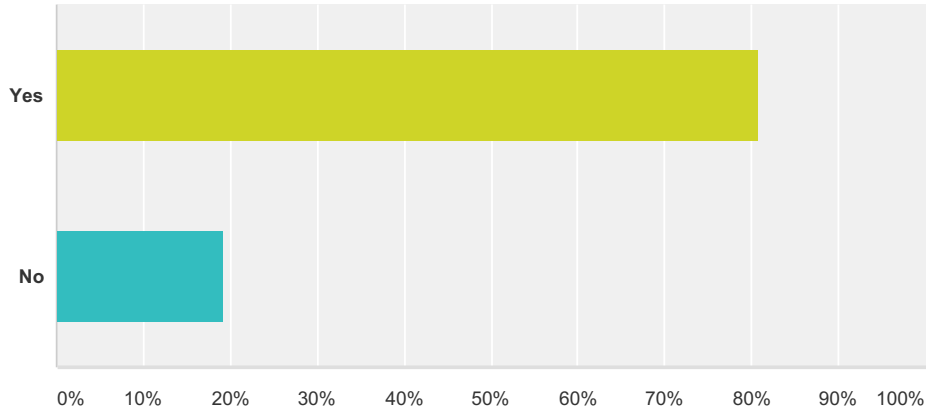

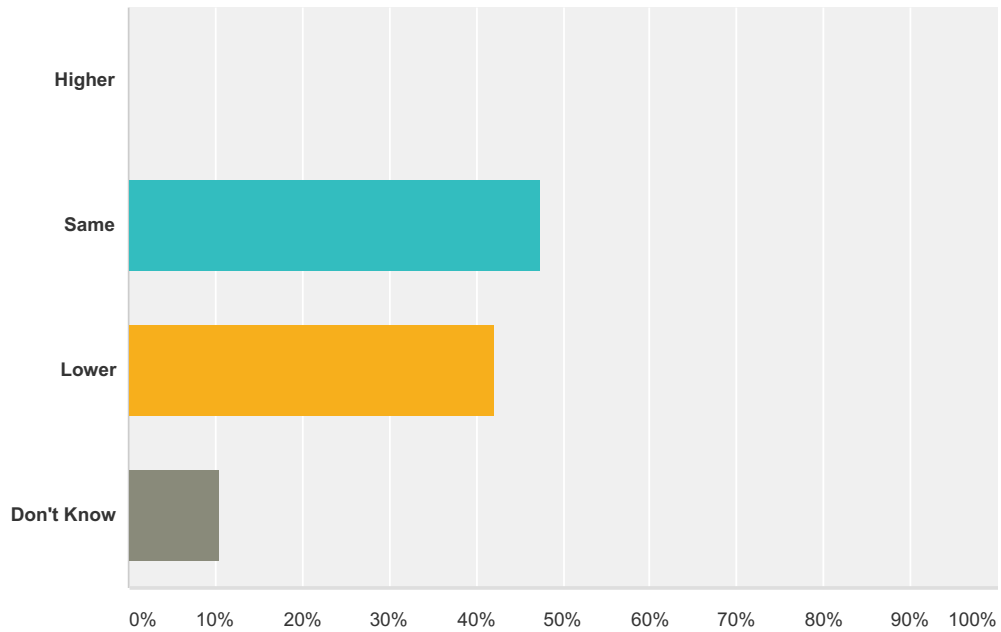
